DONORS HELP BRING IMMEDIATE RELIEF AND SUPPORT TO SAN DIEGO'S SOUTHEAST COMMUNITY



In the wake of the recent record-breaking storm on January 22, 2024, the <u>Jackie Robinson Family YMCA</u> has been a convener, connector, and unifier for the Southeast San Diego community, providing much-needed resources and support. Staff and volunteers are working together alongside their neighbors to provide essential services and aid to those affected by the damage. As a partner in a collaborative of community-based organizations, our Y opened its doors for community to find a sense of safety during these challenging times.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH AND CONCRETE SUPPORTS



Received, sorted, and distributed over 300 individual donations, amassing a total of 2,500+ items, including bags, boxes, and large items.



Swiftly secured hotel stays for 402 residents, including 299 adults and 103 children, ensuring safe, dignified housing for up to two weeks. Residents accessed warm, comfortable hotel rooms within 3-4 hours.



Provided **transportation** to support residents in reaching hotels, work, and other essential destinations.



Offering access to hot showers and hygiene products to 20-30 people per day.



Provided mental health support to residents, volunteers, students, and their families.



Participated in a coordinated effort to provide over **3,000 warm meals.**



Orchestrated teams to clear trash, debris, drywall, flooring, and cabinets from 25 homes, minimizing the impact of mold within a tight timeframe.



Filled and distributed **2,000 sandbags** to assist in flood prevention and protection from subsequent storms.

COLLABORATIVE COORDINATION



Coordinated **200 volunteers and staff** for tasks related to community outreach, labor, intake, housing, and referral navigation, demonstrating the collective power of community.



Staff and volunteers supported residents, formed genuine relationships, and created a sense of safety and trust in the process.



Organized initiatives for volunteers and staff to participate in **cleanup and restoration efforts**, including boots-on-the-ground cleaning crews, coordination, labor, and compassionate support to households vacating unsafe residences.



Advocated and coordinated with public partners across three municipalities and several government agencies.



Provided a **dedicated space for partners to come together**, coordinate efforts, and strategize comprehensive relief initiatives.
